


Seven practical 'how-to' books outlining Biblical principles for today's Church.






**'HEARING GOD'** helps address these and other questions and the many ways in which He communicates with us in this short, easy-to-read format book.

**'BEAUTIFUL BODY'** provides clear guidance on what the Bible teaches about relationships, in a simple, practical manner.






